REQUIREMENTS AND COMMITMENTS



TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Our CASA volunteers complete a 25 hour preservice training or our independent guided learning track along with 5 hours of court observations.



IIME

COMMITMENT

Our CASA volunteers meet with their CASA child once a month and attend any meetings or court hearings that pertain to the case. This looks like 6-10 hours per month.



ONE YEAR COMMITMENT

The court cases we work with can last up to a year or longer. It is our goal to have volunteers stay on the CASA case until their CASA child reaches a safe and permanent home.
