A Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) Volunteer is a trained community volunteer appointed by the Children's Court Judge to speak for the best interests of abused and neglected children.

REQUIREMENTS AND COMMITMENTS



TRAINING REQUIREMENTS

Our CASA volunteers complete a 25 hour pre-service training or our independent guided learning track along with 5 hours of court observations.



TIME COMMITMENT

Our CASA volunteers meet with their CASA child once a month and attend any meetings or court hearings that pertain to the case. This looks like 6-10 hours per month.



ONE YEAR COMMITMENT

The court cases we work with can last up to a year or longer. It is our goal to have volunteers stay on the CASA case until their CASA child reaches a safe and permanent home.
